CSV to HTML

CSVtoHTML will convert a *.csv file to *.htm to display school/business closings on a web site. This is used in conjunction with our StormReady database software for managing school closings.

The files required include: csvtohtml.exe, csvtohtml.ini and mfc71.dll. These files are included in the StormReady setup program. The DLL file does not need to be registered.

Csvtohtml.exe runs from a command line:

cvstohtml csvFilename.csv htmFilename.htm

You may include the full path for each filename if they are not in the same folder as csvtohml.exe. A common usage of this application is to run this program from a batch file and schedule it in the Task Scheduler.

A csvtohtml.ini file can be used and default settings are as follows if the file does not exist initially:

NOTE: If there is no data in the *.csv file, it will put a set message in the *.htm file "There are no schools currently closed".
